

In the case of illness, injury or accident

Accident:

Dial 112 and give the following information:

What has happened?

Where the accident has occurred – exact address! If the accident has happened on the beach, report the beach number **D500**

Your telephone number and name

When you call 112, they will automatically alarm acute helpers from the Acute Helper Service. These acute helpers are trained firstaiders and they should arrive within a few minutes. Then they will give first aid until the ambulance and doctor's car arrive. The acute helpers are trained among other things to use a defibrillator/ heart starter apparatus. Acute helpers wear marked high visibility vests.

Injury

Dial 70 15 03 00 where you will consult a doctor or nurse, who can evaluate whether you should be treated at an emergency centre or whether your injury can be treated by a local doctor's surgery.

Illness

Contact a doctor's surgery. The nearest surgery is.
